English

- * We use fiction and non-fiction texts over the term to produce dialogue and description for story writing, scientific explanations and an information text about London and the locality.
- * A Bear called Paddington and a Walk in London are two example texts
- * We will be reading A Bear called Paddington as a class, whilst children continue to use Accelerated Reader to quiz on their individual books, as well as other stories daily.
- * Regular reading at home as often as possible (at least three times a week) should continue.

PSHE and Production

PSHE - Jigsaw

- * The children use our Jigsaw programme to explore Dreams and Goals in the world around them. In the second half term we will focus on 'Healthy Me'.
- * Our Rock Pool production will take place on 1st and 2nd April. Further details to follow.

Geography and French

Geography

* We will develop our locational knowledge and map skills to be able to locate countries in Europe, North America and South America. We will be comparing cities and geographical features of countries across these continents.

French

* We will be learning how to say which activities we can or can't do, plus learning about the four seasons.

Science and Computing

Science:

* The children will learn about magnets and forces. We will also be developing our working scientifically skills.

- * We start with Dance where we will learn moves to combine into sequences. Later in the term we will develop our hockey skills.

- * We are going to be learning about different strands of two religions this term.
- * The children learn about 'What is it like for someone to follow God?'
- * We learn how festivals and worship show what matters to Muslims. We will be visiting Exeter Mosque as part of our learning.
