English

* We begin the term by reading *The Day the Crayon's quit*, and will be using this text to write letters with appropriate formality.

* Our second English unit will link to our science work on the circulatory system. We will look at the beautiful book Anatomy, and write a scientific explanation about the heart.

* We will be using the short film 'Ruin' to inspire atmospheric writing involving action and flashbacks.

* Our final text is *My Secret War Diary* which will tie into our history topic and our production. The children will be getting into the mindset of an evacuee during the second world war and writing first person accounts.

PSHE and French

PSHE - Jigsaw

* Using the Jigsaw programme children will think about healthy relationships and learn about how we change physically and emotionally as we get older.

French:

* The children will learn which countries in the world speak French. They will also learn about the currencies, flags and traditions of these countries.

History

* We will be diving into the fascinating history of World War II, gaining an understanding of how the world changed during this period and learning key dates and events.

* The children will write an explanation of a particular event in terms of cause and effect, using historical evidence to support and illustrate their explanation.
