





Year 5 and Year 6

Track suit top (optional for outdoor PE)
Black shorts or track suit bottoms
Trainers (outdoor PE)

You will have been notified which day your child comes to school in their PE kit, please check your child has the correct kit on. No sports teams shirts are permitted and wearing denim or school boots will not enable your child to take part easily.
