

Year 2 Summer Term Curriculum



English

- Read and enjoy a range of poems.
- Write a poem.
- Learn how to use familiar and new punctuation correctly including full stops, capital letters, exclamation marks, question marks and using commas to separate items in a list.
- Expand noun phrases when describing things.
- Learn to use subordination (using when, if, that or because) and coordination (using or, and or but).
- Use the present and past tense correctly.

Maths

- Fractions—Learn to recognise equal and unequal parts. Recognise and find a half and a quarter. Identify and find a third.
- Time—Tell the time when it is o'clock and half past, quarter past and quarter to. Tell the time in 5 minute increments.
- Statistics—Collect data using tally charts, make and interpret pictograms.
- Position and Direction—use the correct language to describe movement and turns.

PSHE & RE

Jigsaw: Relationships—Learning about respect and how to solve friendship problems.
Changing Me—Understanding change and expressing our feelings to changes.
RE: Judaism—Who is Jewish and how do they live? What makes places sacred to believers?

Science & Computing

Science: Developing our knowledge of Plants, living things and their habitats. Learn about Healthy eating and the importance of diet and exercise for humans.

ICT:

- Programming - Moving a Robot
- E-Safety - Understanding self image and identity

PE and Music

PE: During the term the children will be developing their athletic skills and improving their fitness. They will learn how to play Cricket and practise their throwing and aiming skills. The children will showcase their skills and abilities during Sports Day.

Music: Charanga - Music that makes you want to dance. Learning songs for our performance.

History and Geography

History: Learning about the significant historical events involving Brunel and the development of the railway. Discovering information about seaside holidays from the past
