### The Curious Quests

- Children will learn to record sentences using capital letters, fingers spaces, punctuation, neat handwriting and with letters sitting on the line.
- Children will explore new skills including:
  - Joining clauses using 'and'
  - Using the suffixes '-ing' and '-ed'
  - Beginning to sequence sentences into short narratives.
- Quests will be taken from a mixture of fiction, non-fiction, poetry and animations.
