

YEAR 4 LEARNING WEB

We hope that you enjoy reading about what we are learning during the autumn term.

English

- * We use several different fiction and non-fiction texts over the term to produce stories, diaries and information texts.
- * We use the 'Marshmallows' video to produce action-packed stories. We also use 'Pugs of the Frozen North' to help sequence our narratives and to focus on character descriptions.
- * Myth Atlas will support us to develop our vocabulary and practise using apostrophes correctly, as well as making links with our history topics.
- * The children are revising key spelling rules to begin with, including how to add suffixes and prefixes. We then focus on finding spelling patterns within the statutory Year 3/4 spelling lists.



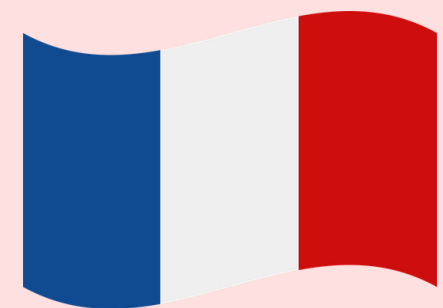
PSHE / French

PSHE - Jigsaw

- * The children use our Jigsaw programme to learn about rights and responsibilities, and how to celebrate differences.

French:

- * We will build our French vocabulary and be able to give personal details about ourselves such as age and nationality, and describe our families.



Maths

- * There is a lot of number work this term. The children begin with place value (1000s, 100s, 10s and 1s) and use equipment to support their learning.
- * We move onto focusing on addition and subtraction of two four-digit numbers.
- * In the second half of the term, it is all about area and returning to learning more of our times tables (3x, 6x, 9x, 7x, 11x, and 12x).
- * We are also starting the Key Stage 2 Mastering Number programme to help develop our understanding of multiplication and division.



ART / DT

Art:

- * Lots of painting this term and we learn about the colour wheel, tints and shades. We study and recreate paintings in the style of several artists including Monet and local artist Brian Pollard.



History / Geography

History:

- * It's time to travel back to Ancient Greece! We will learn about everyday life in Greece, gods and goddesses and the Olympics.

Geography:

- * We will be looking at old and new maps of the local area, drawing our own maps and learning about ordnance survey symbols.

PE / Music

PE:

- * We start with tennis before moving onto handball later in the term.

Music:

- * The children will start to learn songs for our Year 4 production, "What on Earth is Christmas?".
