Planting and Growing

Me and My World



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Increasingly follow rules, understanding why they are important.
- Find solutions to conflicts and friendship issues.

Communication and Language

- Re-tell and discuss familiar nursery rhymes and stories.
- Talk about familiar stories.
- Pay attention to more than one thing at a time and understand a question or instruction that has two parts.

Physical Development

- Use large muscle movements including skipping, hopping and jumping.
- Use one handed tools and equipment.

Literacy

- Develop phonic knowledge and identify certain sounds.
- Engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Develop their own ideas and then decide which materials to use to express them.
- Remember and sing entire songs and sing the pitch of a tone sung by another person.

Mathematics

- Make comparisons between objects relating to size, length, weight and capacity.
- Link numerals and amounts: showing the right number of objects to match the numeral, up to 5.

Understanding the World

- Discuss our favourite journeys and different ways to travel.
- Know that there are different countries in the world and talk about the differences they have experienced or seen in photos.

- Grow a sunflower or runner bean at home. See how tall it can grow.
- Visit a local beach and see what you can find on the seashore.
- Explore and Create (Father's Day).
- Trip to SHJS Green Team—planting.
