

YEAR 5 LEARNING WEB

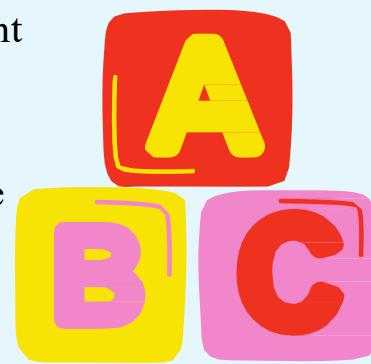
We hope that you enjoy reading about what we are learning during the autumn term.

English

* We are exploring Kensuke's Kingdom through poetry, performance, and narrative writing. We are developing vocabulary, figurative language, and storytelling skills.

* The Lion, The Witch & The Wardrobe helps us to write instructions for different potions and we perform and write villainous speeches.

* The children revisit the sounds a, ay, e, ee, i, ie, o in spelling lessons, whilst some children will revisit other spelling patterns that they are not yet familiar with.



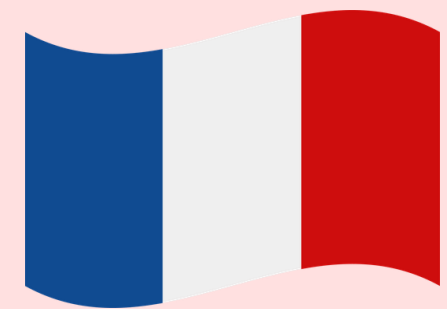
PSHE / French

PSHE:

* The children use our Jigsaw programme to answer the question 'Who am I and How do I fit in the world?' and later focus on celebrating differences.

French:

* We learn some basic French sounds to help learn about the alphabet and begin to learn about pets.



Maths

* There is a lot of number work this term. The children begin with place value - Roman numerals in thousands and numbers up to a million. The children need to learn how to read/write numbers in 1 000s, 10 000s and 100 000s. Can they show you?

* We move onto a focus of addition and subtraction, before later in the term looking at multiplication and division.

* We begin work on fractions, by adding and subtracting and simplifying common denominators.

* We use TTRockstars (particularly for catch-up and division facts) as well as Mathletics in class with Home Learning to support this.



ART / DT

Art:

* We'll be working towards mastering drawing techniques this term beginning with hatching and cross-hatching.



History / Geography

History:

* We will be discovering what life was like in Anglo-Saxon times.

Geography:

* The children will be studying the development of Exeter and comparing the South-West region with a region in Poland.

PE / Music

PE:

* We start with football and develop skills in dance later in the term, whilst continuing building orienteering skills

Music:

* The music this term focuses on learning the recorder, including reading notes on a stave.



RE

* We are learning about Humanism as a world view.

* Later in the term, we use Christianity to answer the question, 'Why do Christians believe Jesus was the Messiah?'



Science / Computing

Science:

* The children will learn all about different forces, whilst undertaking experiments and remembering key words.

Computing:

* We look at how to share information safely and self-image.
* To understand computer systems.
