- * We will read extracts from *What Darwin Saw* and write our own scientific journal linked to our science topic
- * During the first half term we will be reading *The Highland Falcon Thief* as our class Novel. This will then be the focus of our English lessons for the entire second half term. We will be writing our own mystery stories based on the novel.
- * The children continue to learn and practise using new words each week based on a weekly sound. They will also be encouraged to correctly use the words from the statutory word lists in their writing.
