- Begin to understand nouns and verbs

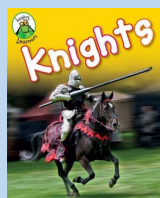
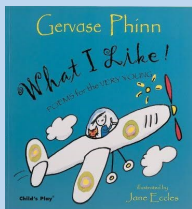
