# **English**

- \* We use fiction and non-fiction texts over the term to produce dialogue for story writing, biographical work and information text about London and the locality.
- \* Paddington and a Walk in London are two text examples.
- \* Guided reading will link to our science learning about Forces.
- \* We will be reading A Bear called Paddington as a class, whilst children continue to use Accelerated Reader to quiz on their individual books, as well as other stories daily.
- \* The children are taught the sounds or/f/g/j/k/l in spelling lessons this half term and m/n/r/s/t/sh. Alongside this the children will develop their reading fluency.
- \* Regular reading at home as often as possible (at least three times a week) should continue.

## **PSHE and Production**

PSHE - Jigsaw

- \* The children use our Jigsaw programme to explore Dreams and Goals in the world around them. In the second half term we will focus on 'Healthy Me'.
- \* Our Pirates & Mermaids play will take place on 28th/29th March. Further details to follow.

- \* We will develop our place knowledge to understand geographical similarities and differences of a region within the UK.
- \* We will study the human and physical characteristics of countries and major cities of the world.

# **Science and Computing**

#### Science:
